

SGSDS DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW RULES

- Open to SGSDS members who have shown at least 2 SGSDS sanctioned schooling dressage shows by two different judges before the closing of the Championship Show of the current year, and the new year begins after the Championship Show. Rider must be a member at the time the score is obtained.
- Rider and horse qualify as a combination-no substitute horse or rider is allowed. Qualifying scores need to be at the same level. A horse/ rider combination may only compete at one level at the Championship Show.
- The Championship is open to Starter riders and Green as Grass Horses for Introductory and Training Level only.
- The following **minimum percentages** must have been received in any 2 tests at any level at any two SGSDS sanctioned shows: **Starter thru F.E.I.** = 55%; **Musical Freestyle** = no minimum; **Quadrille** = no minimum; **Pas de Deux** = no minimum.
- The highest test in the level is to be ridden in the Championship Show.
- SGSDS Championship Show Rules will be followed so please consult the rule book.
- Riders may not have a reader for the SGSDS Championship Show.
- Whips will not be permitted for the SGSDS Championship Show.
- **No one other than the competitor may ride the horse at any time.** The only exception to this rule would be if the horse is being shown by more than one competitor.

- Horse/rider combinations who win at the Championship Show may not enter the following year's show at the same level.
